

ENROLLMENT DEFINITIONS

For financial aid eligibility and enrollment certification for loan deferments, insurance coverage and other purposes, the enrollment status of students is defined as the following:

Undergraduate Students

Enrollment Type	Credit Hours
Full-time	12+
Three-quarter-time	9-11
Half-time	6-8
Less-than-half-time	1-5

Graduate Students

Enrollment Type	Credit Hours
Full-time	8+
Three-quarter-time	6-7
Half-time	4-5
Less-than-half-time	1-3

For summer, the statuses listed above may be fulfilled by enrollment in one or more sessions within the summer semester, including summer intersession. Courses receiving an AU, NF or SF mark are not counted in enrollment credit hours. This definition differs from the one used for assessing tuition and fees (for more information, see Office of the Bursar website).
